<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> A **household** is defined as all persons who share a common kitchen or bath. This includes tax dependent college students who are absent from the household solely because of college attendance, they may not apply as separate households.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> **Household income** is defined as the gross income of all household members, except wage or salary income earned by dependent minors under 18 years of age. Head of household and spouse may never be considered as minors. Gross income includes wages, interest, annuities, pensions, social security retirement, disability, public assistance, Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), alimony, child support, unemployment benefits, workers compensation, and any other indirect income such as utility allowance.

<b>Option 1:</b> Ohio EPA can mail your certificate to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) upon completion. The BMV is the agency that issues the license plates & stickers. If you would like to take advantage of this service, please include the following:
□ a check or money order for your registration renewal fee made out to: Treasurer State of Ohio;
□ your signed Application for Renewal Registration by mail notice; and
□ an unsealed stamped envelope, addressed to the BMV. The BMV's address is on the Registration notice. (Note: if a pre-addressed stamped envelope is not included, everything will be returned).
OR
Option 2: Ohio EPA will e-mail your certificate ID to you so that you can renew online at www.Oplates.com. If you would like to take advantage of this service, please include your e-mail address on the line below.
4. If your application is approved, you will receive an extension certificate. Once you receive your certificate, you may apply to renew your registration. For questions regarding your registration, title, etc. call the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) at 1-800-589-8247. Please allow up to 10 business days for Ohio EPA to process your application. If your application is denied, all materials will be returned to the mailing address you provide on page one.

5. Please mail this application and additional documents to one of the following E-Check offices, or stop by to have your extension processed while you wait. You can also take this application and other required paperwork to any of the 23 full service E-Check stations and have it processed while you wait. 6. Please remember that the hardship extension does not exempt your vehicle from testing. It simply extends the deadline, allowing up to six additional months for you to pass E-Check. You will not be able to renew your registration the following year until your vehicle has received a passing inspection certificate or waiver. You are not allowed another hardship extension on this vehicle next year and it is not transferable upon selling the vehicle.
