- 18 self-service kiosks located outside many of the existing E Check stations and 3 self-testing kiosks near a License Bureau, where you can conduct your own On-Board Diagnostic (OBD) test. Open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year!

Avoid the Busiest Times

Ohio E Check Full-Service stations are usually less busy before 9 a.m. and after 4 p.m.

23 Full-Service Station Hours

Monday–Friday: 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Saturday: 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Closed Sundays and select state holidays.

Vehicles Must Be Tested Prior to Registration in Seven Ohio E Check Counties

Gasoline and diesel vehicles 6–25 years old and non-plug-in hybrids 7–25 years old that are 10,000 lbs. or less GVWR are subject to emissions testing. The testing cycle is every two years where odd model year vehicles are tested in odd years and even model vehicles are tested in even years. Non-plug-in hybrids start testing in an off year and is

tested again if the certificate has expired by the following year to begin the normal 2-year test cycle in the odd or even year corresponding to the model year of their vehicle. For example, a 2020 vehicle or a 2019 hybrid would begin testing in 2026. A 2019 hybrid would then test again in 2027 to begin the normal 2-year test cycle. Test certificates are effective for 365 days. Motorists purchasing a used vehicle must obtain a valid E Check certificate for registration. A passing certificate is good for 365 days and is transferable to a new owner. To protect yourself when purchasing a used vehicle four years old or older, be sure to ask for a passing E Check certificate before purchasing the vehicle.

Vehicle Test History

A vehicle's test history and unexpired test certificate numbers can be obtained at www.ohiocheck.info using the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN). If there is a valid test, a copy can be obtained at any one of the E Check testing locations.

Watch the Mail for Notification

Motorists will receive a courtesy reminder of the required test at least 90 days prior to registration renewal. **However, motorists can get vehicles tested up to 365 days before your required registration renewal date.**

Those who may not be in Ohio when their registration is due should test early — for example, wintering in another state or students attending school.
